Although you can register on-site on the day of the event, online registration is preferred to ensure we have ample materials for the Adventurers & Participants.

The Club Director (or Appointee) or the Parent may Register the Participants. The Cost is \$12.00 per Adventurer or Other Participant & INCLUDES a Fun Day Pin. A Fun Day Pin will be available at the event for each *Paid Online Registration*.

If you would like ADDITIONAL pins, you can purchase them on the JotForm. The fees will be paid during online registration via JotForm.

Admission is free for adults.

Since the order will have already been placed, on-site Registrations will NOT receive a pin. Any on-site payments can be made with cash, check, PayPal or credit card.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURES & CLUB CHECK IN:

The Adventurer Director, a Representative, or the Parent should report to Check-In upon arrival. All other Adventurers & Club Members should proceed to the Worship Area.

Starting at 9:30 a.m., everyone will proceed into the gym by the stage for the Opening Worship Service. Clubs with children participating in the Flag Processional for Opening Worship Service must arrive by 9:30 a.m. for an orientation with Dr. David Kessler.

Each club is to sit together to assist with orderly dismissal for the Parade, so **bring your flags, and/or banner** with you. If lawn chairs are brought for staff, these need to be placed on the outside edge of your space.

SAFETY ISSUES

Please remember that all clubs are responsible to have and bring the medical release forms/health insurance records for all attending club members.

Parking is on the church side of the parking lot. When arriving, be very mindful of children walking to the school's side landing. We ask that once your car is parked, that it not be moved until the event is done at 3:00 p.m.

Parents should accompany Adventurers as they rotate through all the sessions. Except for the parade, all activities will occur in assigned areas of the school property, including the right portion of the lower field where the track is located.

There is a creek on the premises; this area is off-limits to the clubs.

Also, the church has asked that you don't approach or feed the wildlife and venture beyond the porta-johns into the left lower field where private campsites are located.

A basic first aid kit can be found at the First Aid Station (Registration Tent).

FOOD

Please bring your own packed lunches; there is no onsite food available for purchase. Lunch will be outdoors on the lawn from 12:00-12:55 p.m. Because there are only 3 picnic tables in the school's playground, plan to sit on the lawn and bring a tarp or picnic blanket, etc. Please place your trash in the trash cans on the premises. The Third Session will begin promptly at 1:00 p.m.

Water will be available in a cooler at the Water Station.

FOOD IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE GYM

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PARADE

Please assist the Parade Coordinator by quickly getting your club to stand in your assigned area. Have your club line up with your banner first, then the flags, and for large clubs: children in lines of four across, one line behind the other; small clubs: children in lines of 2 across, one line behind the other. Staff will need to march with the children as well to keep them in line and on the parade route.

The parade will begin from the Opening/Closing Service Area and proceed up the hill to the church parking lot. A Group Photo will be taken immediately after the parade.

ACTIVITIES

What is a Fun Day without doing fun activities? There are 4 Sessions that each group will rotate through, following the theme of Travel by Faith which will help the children grow in their basic relationships of their lives: My God, My Self, My Family and My World. Also, we are excited to offer 2 awards this year, **Country Fun** and **International**, from the Florida Conference.

The First Session will begin after the Group picture at 10:30 a.m. and sessions will run 40 minutes long with a 10- minute walk time to the next session. Sessions will occur outdoors, so dress appropriately for the weather. In the event of rain or extreme cold weather, all activities will be moved indoors to the school.

Please use the porta-johns at the lower field when outdoors. There are only 2 restrooms on the gym level; please use these rest rooms only when you are rotating for activities on the gym level.

DEPARTURE PROCEDURES

When the Fourth Session ends at 2:30 p.m., each club needs to clean up the area around their activities. Once your children have completed the trash sweep, proceed to the Closing Ceremony Area in the gym.

CLOSING CEREMONY

This is a chance for all to reflect on our theme, congratulate those clubs that have followed the point system and kick off our new 2025-2026 theme.
