General Information

Welcome to The Great I Am Adventurer Fun Day.

Participants may be registered by the Club Director, club appointee or the parent.

Cost is \$12.00 per Adventurer child, paid during online registration (free pin included).

Admission is free for adults (pins may be purchased on registration form).

Since the order will have already been placed, on-site registrations will **NOT** receive a pin. Any on-site payments can be made with cash, check, PayPal or credit card.

Fun Day Pins should be available at the event for each online-registered Adventurer. If the pins are not ready yet, they will be mailed out to club Directors shortly after the event.

Arrival Procedures / Club Check-in:

Adventurer Director, representative, or the parent should check-in upon arrival. Club members should proceed to the worship area.

Starting at 9:30 a.m., everyone will proceed to the gym by the stage for the Opening Worship Service. Adventurers participating in the Flag Processional for Opening Worship Service must arrive by 9:30 a.m., for their orientation with Dr. David Kessler.

Each club is to sit together to assist with orderly dismissal for the Parade. **Please bring your flags, and/or banner** with you. Any lawn chairs should be placed on the outside edge of your space.

Safety Issues

Please remember that all clubs are responsible for bring the medical release forms/health insurance records for all attending club members.

Parking is on the church side of the parking lot. Upon arrival, be mindful of children walking to the school's side landing. Once your car is parked it should not be moved until the event is done at 3:00 p.m.

Parents should accompany Adventurers as they rotate through all the sessions. Except for the parade, all activities will occur in assigned areas on the school property. Please note, there is **no access to the lower field** this year due to new construction. Please keep off the grass of the lower field.

The creek on the premises is off-limits. Please do not approach or feed the wildlife.

A basic first-aid kit can be found at the First-Aid Station (Registration Tent).

Food

Please bring your own packed lunches; there is no onsite food available for purchase. Lunch will be outdoors on the lawn from 12:00 - 12:55 p.m. There are only 3 picnic tables in the school's playground, plan to sit on the lawn and utilize your picnic blanket, lawn chairs, tarp, etc. Please place your trash in the trash cans on the premises. The Third Session will begin promptly at 1:00 p.m.

Water will be available in a cooler at the Water Station.

Parade

Please assist the Parade coordinator by quickly getting your club to stand in your assigned area. Have your club line up with your banner first, then the flags, and for large clubs: children in lines of four across, one line behind the other; small clubs: children in lines of two across, one line behind the other. Staff will need to march with the children as well to keep them in line and on the parade route.

The parade will begin from the Opening/Closing Service Area and proceed up the hill to the church parking lot. Immediately after the parade, there will be a group photo.

Activities

What is a Fun Day without doing fun activities? There are 4 Sessions that each group will rotate through. Each will follow the theme of "The Great I AM." These sessions will help the children grow in the basic relationships of their lives: My God, My Self, My Family and My World. There is one session that will use **bug racers**; we are asking clubs to have their bugs made up ahead of time to bring to the Fun Day. Directors can order kits from: www.ssww.com/item/educraft-bugs-on-wheels-craft-kit-GP567. Once completed, the directors can keep all their club's bug racers in one container to bring for the event.

The first session will begin after the group picture at 10:30 a.m. Sessions will run 40 minutes long with a 10-minute walk time to the next session. Some sessions may occur outdoors, dress appropriately for the weather. In the event of rain or extreme cold weather, all activities will be moved indoors to the school.

Due to the restriction from using the lower field, school restrooms may be used. The primary restrooms are on the first floor. There are only two restrooms on the gym level; please use these restrooms only when you are rotating for activities on the gym level.

Departure Procedures

When the fourth session ends at 2:30 p.m., each club needs to clean up the area around their activities. Once your children have completed the trash sweep, proceed to the Closing Ceremony Area in the gym.

Closing Ceremony

This is an opportunity for all to reflect on our theme, congratulate those clubs that have followed the point system, and kick off our new 2024 - 2025 theme.
